

Albert Einstein: a biography



Albert Einstein was born in Germany in 1879 where he lived with his parents and younger sister, Maja. When Albert's father gave him a compass when he was five years old, his interest in magnetism was sparked and from that moment, he knew he wanted to be a scientist.

He was also a very musical child and would later become an accomplished violinist. Despite being clever, he wasn't a very good student. He preferred to learn about philosophy, maths and science from books than to pay attention in the classroom.

In 1894 Albert's family moved to Italy and Albert was sent to college in Switzerland. He graduated in 1900 with a degree in maths and physics. Three years later he married his girlfriend, Milena Maric. Albert's first job was in a Patent Office where he had the opportunity to examine other people's inventions.

This is where he started to develop his own theories and where he gained a better understanding of the laws of physics. Later, in 1914 he became the director of a new research institute in Berlin, Germany and the following year he proved to the world that even the smallest amount of mass could be turned into energy when he presented his 'Theory of Relativity' and the equation, e=mc².

In 1919, Albert and Milena's marriage ended and shortly afterwards he married Elsa Lowenthal. In 1921 he received the Nobel Prize for Physics and spent the next two years travelling, first to the USA and then to Japan, Singapore and Spain. He moved to the USA in 1933 where he worked continually until his death from heart failure at the age of 76.


